Practical Information for the 31st ESC

Admission Requirements

- This course is open to mid-career peace and security professionals working in national ministries. In addition, the course is open to selected representatives of international and civil society organisations.
- Participants should possess a university degree or be serving officers (Advanced Military Staff Course completed). As the course is highly interactive throughout, candidates must have some professional or academic experience in the field of international peace and security. Post-graduate training and/or mission experience are assets but not required.
- The ESC relies on the active engagement and interaction of all participants. **Full-time attendance** is therefore required for the entire duration of the course, both the virtual and in-person parts.
- As English is the working language of the ESC, participants are expected to have a strong command of the language, both spoken and written.

The Pedagogical Approach & Delivery Modalities

The course will blend in-person learning with virtual education. It is going to take place in two parts:

- **Part 1:** 25 January - 19 February 2027 – Virtual phase (fully online, via Zoom)
- **Part 2:** 22 February - 19 March 2027 – In-person phase (at the GCSP, in Geneva)

This combination of delivery modalities takes into account the growing preference towards more flexibility in professional training. This course format also allows for greater diversity, equity, and inclusion to provide participants with wider perspectives and a more effective learning environment.

Application Procedure

Only completed applications sent through our application system by the deadline will be considered for the selection phase.

Please note that the following documents will need to be sent by email (esc@gcsp.ch) upon registration for each candidate:

- A letter of reference outlining the candidate's suitability for the course, signed by the sending authority (i.e. direct supervisor or department head)
- A curriculum vitae
- A passport scan

Selection Process

Given the high number of strong applications received each year and the limited number of places available, admission to the course is highly competitive. The GCSP aims to select 24 participants, ensuring diversity in ministerial representation, national origin, professional experience, educational and training background, and gender.

Please also note that former participants of GCSP advanced courses (the ITC/LISC and the NISC) are not eligible to apply.

Course Fees

With the support of the Swiss Confederation, we are pleased to offer this course free of tuition charges.

Travel Costs (Part 2: In-person phase)

Travel costs between the home country and Geneva are the responsibility of the sending institutions.

Assessment and Certificate

Participants are assessed based on their participation throughout the course and their performance in assigned activities and tasks. After successful completion of the course, participants will receive a Course Certificate from the GCSP, a PIP Partnership Training and Education Centre (PTEC), as well as being ISO 9001 certified. An assessment letter will be provided to the sending institution.
